

Proposed Changes to Hole #6

Our grounds crew has proposed to make changes to Hole #6. The idea was presented to the Board of Directors at our September meeting. The Board of Directors has decided that since the changes proposed are quite substantial, that the input from our members is necessary.

The proposed changes are as follows:

1. The green side bunker to the right of the #6 green be removed. As some may have noticed the sand was emptied at the end of the season. Due to the proximity of the trees and lack of sun this bunker requires a lot of attention to keep it free of debris and it is hard to maintain the playability of the sand when it is wet.
2. Extend the green to the area where the bunker is to create a larger green with contours.
3. Create a smaller green side bunker on the left side of the green on the hill. This will potentially reduce lost balls in the trees to the left of the green and speed up playing time.
4. Create a large fairway bunker along the tree line on Hole #6. Exact dimensions are still being discussed but the idea for this bunker is also to speed up pace of play by reducing the number of balls that end up in the trees that separate Hole #6 and Hole #8 fairways. The proposed location would fit along the tree line with the bunker not extending past the red and white target in the trees. Total length has not been decided.

We are asking for feedback on the proposed changes so that we can make a decision on this project for the spring of 2018. We will be addressing this at our AGM on November 30, 2017.
